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How Long Does It Take to Pack a House for Moving?

It depends on the size of your home and who's doing the packing. A studio can be packed in 1 day, while a 4bedroom house may take up to 6 days if you're packing yourself. Professionals can do it much faster.

• **Studio/1-bed:** 1–2 days (DIY), 2–4 hours (pros)

• **2-bed:** 2–4 days (DIY), 3–5 hours (pros)

• **3-bed:** 4–6 days (DIY), 5–8 hours (pros)

• **4-bed:** 5–7+ days (DIY), 8–12 hours (pros)

How Many Hours Should I Set Aside for Packing Each Room?

Packing each room can take 1–5 hours depending on contents and complexity. Kitchens and home offices often take longer due to fragile or valuable items.

• **Kitchen:** 4–5 hours

• Living Room: 2–4 hours • **Bedroom:** 2–3 hours

• **Bathroom:** 1–2 hours

• **Garage/Storage:** 3–5 hours

What Factors Affect the Time It Takes to Pack for a Move?

Key factors include home size, number of belongings, your pace, and whether you get help. More clutter and sentimental items usually mean more time needed.

- Property size and number of rooms
- Number of items and level of organisation
- Work schedule or family responsibilities
- Availability of professional help

How Much Faster Is It to Use Professional Packing Services?

Professionals can pack a home in one-quarter of the time it takes most people. Two trained packers can pack a 3-bedroom home in 5-8 hours.

Professional Packing Service – Average Packing Times

DIY Packing Timeline

- Weeks 6–5: Declutter and sort items
- Weeks 4–3: Pack storage, décor, books
- Weeks 2–1: Pack clothes, kitchenware
- Moving Week: pack essentials, label everything

How Long Does It Take to Unpack After Moving?

Unpacking can take 1–3 weeks depending on how much you moved and how well you packed. Start with essentials and take time to settle in.

- Unpack room-by-room
- Label boxes clearly to speed up process
- Dispose of packing materials as you go
