The Basics of Pricing a Man and Van Service

When hiring a <u>man and van in London</u>, pricing typically depends on several key factors. Whether you're relocating across the city or simply need help moving furniture, understanding these elements can help you budget effectively.

Hourly Rates

Most man and van services charge by the hour. This is ideal for local moves, where you pay only for the time required to complete the job.

Distance Travelled

If you're moving from one borough to another or out of the city, the total mileage might be factored into the cost.

Load Size

Larger loads may require a bigger van or multiple trips, which can increase the total price.

How much does a man and van cost in London?

Average Price Ranges

Here's what you can expect to pay, on average:

- £30-£50/hour Small van with 1 man
- £50-£70/hour Medium van with 1 man
- £70-£90/hour Large van with 2 men
- **£90-£110/hour** Extra-large van with 2 men
- **£110-£130/hour** Luton van with 2 men (ideal for house moves)

Most companies have a minimum booking time of two hours and offer pricing in half-hour increments after that.

What affects the cost of a man and van service?

Several variables can influence the overall cost of your move:

- Number of helpers: More men mean faster service, but higher hourly rates.
- Van size: Bigger vans cost more but can save time and reduce trips.
- Time of day/week: Evening or weekend moves may carry a premium.
- Access issues: Stairs, narrow hallways, or no lift may increase the workload and cost.
- Distance: Long-distance moves will likely add mileage charges.

Is it cheaper to hire a man and van or a removals company?

Generally, a man and van service is more affordable than a full <u>>removals company</u>

- Small house or flat moves
- Furniture or appliance delivery
- student moves
- office relocations with limited equipment

Full removal companies offer packing, storage, and more complex logistics but come at a higher cost.

Do man and van services charge by the hour or by the job?

Most <u>man with a van London</u> providers charge by the hour, with rates increasing based on the van size and number of movers. Some companies may offer fixed prices for specific routes or jobs, but this is less common in central London.

Are there any hidden fees with man and van services?

While reputable companies are upfront about costs, some hidden fees might still appear:

- Congestion Charge: Moves through central London may incur this fee.
- **Parking Fees:** If you can't provide a permit or space, the cost may be passed on.
- Waiting Time: Delays caused by the customer may be charged additionally.
- Stairs: Extra charges often apply for upper-floor deliveries (typically £10-£20 per floor).
- Packing services: Packing and unpacking aren't included by default and cost extra.

Can I travel in the van with the driver?

In most cases, yes—many companies allow one passenger to ride along, which can save on transport costs. However, confirm this when booking as policies may vary, especially post-COVID.
