What size van is best for moving a one-bedroom flat?

A <u>medium wheelbase van</u> (like a Ford Transit Custom) is usually the best fit for a one-bedroom flat. It offers a balance of capacity and manoeuvrability for city moves.

This type of van typically holds 30–40 boxes and small furniture, ideal for compact relocations.

#### Can a one-bedroom flat fit in a small van?

Yes, but only if you have minimal belongings. A small van like a Ford Connect works for basic moves or if most furniture is already moved separately.

- Volume: approx. 3–4 cubic metres
- Ideal for: a few boxes, bags, and compact furniture

#### Do I need a Luton van for a one-bedroom move?

Not always. A <u>Luton moving van</u> may be too large unless you have bulky furniture or appliances. Choose it if you're moving with wardrobes, sofas, or a washing machine.

Its tail lift helps with loading heavy items, but parking might be harder.

## How many boxes can fit in a medium removals van?

A medium van fits 30–40 standard moving boxes or a mix of boxes and small furniture.

Here's a quick breakdown:

- 10–15 large boxes
- 10–15 medium boxes
- 5–10 small boxes
- Plus: chairs, TV units, flat-packed furniture

# Is one man and van enough for a one-bedroom flat?

Usually, yes. One man and a van works for most small moves. But if you live on a higher floor or have heavy items, consider hiring 2 men for efficiency.

It also depends on how much help you can provide during loading.

## How long does it take to move a one-bedroom flat?

Most one-bedroom flat moves take 2 to 4 hours, depending on stairs, distance, and how packed your items are.

#### Time estimates:

- 2 hours local moves, ground floor
- 3–4 hours stairs, longer distances, packing included

# What should I consider when choosing van size for a move?

Key factors include volume of items, size of furniture, access to property, and parking space.

## Ask yourself:

- Do you have large furniture?
- Is your flat up multiple flights of stairs?
- Is parking limited or restricted?

## How much does it cost to hire a van for a one-bedroom move?

Prices start at £50–£60/hour for one man and a medium van. Costs increase based on van size, number of helpers, and travel time.

#### Typical pricing breakdown:

Small van: from £45/hour
Medium van: from £60/hour
Luton van: from £75/hour

## What's the difference between small, medium, and large vans?

The main differences are in loading space and capacity.

## Van Size Volume Best for

Small 3–4 m³ Boxes & small items Medium 6–8 m³ One-bedroom flats Large/Luton 10–18 m³ Bulky furniture
