? General Rule of Thumb:

- ? Book 2–4 weeks in advance for most local moves
- ? Book 4–6 weeks ahead during peak seasons like summer, weekends, and month-end

What Factors Affect How Early You Should Book?

- 1. Time of Year
 - ? High Demand: Summer months, school holidays, end-of-tenancy dates, and December
 - ?? Low Demand: Mid-week days in winter (January–February)
- 2. Size of the Move
 - ? Studio or 1-bed flat: 1–2 weeks may be sufficient
 - ? Large house or office: Book 3–6 weeks ahead, especially if packing is required
- 3. Moving Distance
 - ? Local moves: Less planning needed
 - ? Long-distance or multi-stop moves: Require early coordination and booking
- 4. Day of the Week
 - ? Weekends and Fridays: High demand book early
 - ? Tuesdays to Thursdays: More flexible and may cost less
